Dr. B. Mohana Kumar, General Secretary, COFAA welcomed all the members. Dr. H. R. V. Reddy, presided over the meeting as the President of COFAA.


Firstly, the proceedings of the previous EC meeting were discussed and reviewed. Subsequently, the following items were discussed and approved for the needful action.

1. It was decided to submit the memorandum on the filling-up of vacant Assistant Director of Fisheries (ADF) posts along with Assistant Manager posts in the Karnataka Fisheries Development Corporation (KFDC) in the Department of Fisheries, Govt. of Karnataka. The Hon'ble Minister for Fisheries, Ports and Inland Transport, the Principal Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry and Fisheries and the Director of Fisheries would be apprised in this regard for initiating the recruitment process at the earliest.
2. It was also decided to submit the memorandum on the recruitment of teaching and non-teaching posts and Subject Matter Specialists (along with list of vacant posts) in the College of Fisheries, Mangaluru and Krishi Vigyan Kendra's (KVKs), respectively. The representations would soon be made to the Hon'ble Ministers for Animal Husbandry, and Fisheries, Ports and Inland Transport, the

Principal Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry and Fisheries, the Vice Chancellor and the Registrar of KVAFSU and the Dean, College of Fisheries, Mangaluru for early needful action.

3. The proposal of organising 'First Annual Get Together of COFAA' along with an International/national symposium was discussed, and it was decided to conduct for two days in the second week of December 2022. As deliberated earlier, COFAA would delegate and assign the responsibility of organising 'First Annual Get Together of COFAA-2022' to the outgoing BFSc 'Silver jubilee' batch of 1997. The tentative plan of the two-days programme will be discussed in the forthcoming EC meetings in consultation with the Alumni of 1993-97 batch.
4. To regularly update the COFAA activities through digital and social media, below EC members have been entrusted for the necessary action.

5. Dr. T. S. Annappasway and Dr. S. K. Girisha have been requested for overseeing the completion and updating of registrations of recently passed-out Alumni to COFAA, and also working on the transfer of registration fee from KVAFSU, Bidar to the COFAA account at the earliest possible.
6. Dr. S. R. Somashekar and Dr. S. K. Girisha as Coordinators/In-charge of Alumni guest house were requested for taking necessary measures for regular repairs/maintenance, and purchases of essential items for the guest house. It was decided to accept the guest house charges through UPI system and create a QR code in this regard. It was also approved to explore the possibility of installing a separate electric meter for COFAA guest house through MESCOM, Mangaluru.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks by Dr. Prakash Patil, Joint Secretary, COFAA.
